6. Old Business:

- a. Blood drive date is December 8 –Theron. To improve collection, a suggestion was made to also use the café once dining ceases at 2PM. This was considered and might be implemented, but Theron noted that the "long pole in the tent" to activate this improvement is the number of trained Red Cross personnel assigned.
- b. Facilities Committee Mike provided a short update on current projects. He will meet with patio contractors to ensure their work meets our standards.

7. New Business:

- a. Veterans Day Ceremony: Post 176 and VFW will have a small, joint, socially distanced ceremony in tribute to veterans on 11 Nov 2020, 1100 hrs at Post 176. Participation will be limited in light of COVID 19 guidance.
- b. In the course of his presentation as IGM, Marty voiced the need for IT improvements, specifically networking Post 176 computers. He presented a motion that the Post authorize an expenditure of \$10,000 for such IT improvement. Discussion of the motion revealed that purchase of an additional server would allow the Post to upgrade its IT, increase system responsiveness and improve system security, including mandatory individual passwords for system operators. The motion was unanimously approved for presentation at Nov 2020 GMM with a recommendation of approval.
- c. Craig noted that he was required to pay an increased price for meals at the café. The leadership was mystified at this. The commander noted that the reason for our operations as a post is to serve veterans. Jim Fisher recounted anecdotes of less well off patrons regular use of the café. Post 176 does not have to match community restaurants as we have a different mission. No action has been approved to increase prices at the Warrior Café.
