Sons of the American Legion Squadron No 176 Commander Rodriguez opened the General Membership Meeting at 7:34 p.m. on November 17th at the American Legion Post No 176, Springfield, Virginia.

Campbell made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 13th General Membership Meeting as written and seconded by Vanice. The motion passed unanimously.

The Adjutant reported that membership is doing well, with it being at 60 renewed members for the year with a target of 70 members by December 4th. He also mentioned that Governor Northam's latest Executive Orders may affect events at the post and that the Post Executive Committee is meeting tonight to discuss this topic. It is believed the post will not stop events and can follow the new regulations. Lastly, he mentioned that the Eagle Scout Citation was postponed this month due to Post Commander Madtes attending the Department Commanders Dinner at Post 24. It is planned to present these items to William Wolfe at the next Post GMM.

The Finance Officer gave his report on September and October.

Under unfinished business, Vanice briefly discussed the reason why there are two SAL Accounts showing, one being the Squadrons Account and the second being the SAL District Account.

Vanice showed the members a resolution for supporting him as the Detachment Vice Commander again for the upcoming year and was supported by the Post and squadron.

For the Good of the Sons, Jones mentioned that the Thanksgiving event at the post could use volunteers and for anyone interested in assisting to contact the General Manager.

Vanice mentioned that he will look into face coverings to create, or purchase, and sell at the post if he can get approval from the post.

The Commander reminded us that the next General Membership meeting will be on December 8th at 7:30 pm.

With the colors of the Nation being in place, the Commander rendered a hand salute and moved that the meeting be adjourned, which was seconded by Vanice and was declared closed at 7:52 p.m.
