**U. S. Welcome for Afghan Interpreter:** As you recall, The American Legion led the VSO effort to help coalition Afghan and

Iraqi translators or “Terps” (short for Interpreters) gain access to the United States. Post 24 Adjutant Jim Glassman wrote a Resolution that moved up the chain and was ultimately passed by the National Office. Initially, the visa program was working, and visas were available for some of these combat partners, but the Coronavirus resulted in the closure of the Kabul embassy which processed visas. One of the first Afghan Interpreters to arrive in the U.S. since the Kabul Embassy reopened, was “Sediq”. On 15 June, Post 24 reps joined the *No One Left Behind* organization to greet the translator and his family upon their arrival to Dulles International Airport.
