## 1. Old Business:

- a. Facilities Committee: top 3 projects Mike
  - 1) Replacing door units in front, Representative said they can't get parts anymore. After conducting a site survey, they have everything in stock for new ones. Will schedule immediately as soon as they have an opening
  - 2) Doors on north side are on hold for repairs
  - 3) Supply company is waiting for parts for dishwasher
  - 4) Waiting on repair part for oven
  - 5) Spoke to Bun about coffee maker, agreed to replace, originally was supposed to come in March, came in early
  - 6) Water leak in cafe, called the company that did the original work. Wasn't' their work. Found the scooper that pushes water into drains, had separated due to ice between flashing, gave quote to do all 9 at a very good price, will also open so the water will drain away from building
  - 7) Fire sprinkler system inspection 4 of the shutoff values stuck, working with companies to fix
  - 8) Leak in upstairs restroom, that was repaired
  - 9) Microwave in kitchen broke must be replaced
  - 10) Looking for different quotes for repair of patio received 1 quote, biggest issue company will not guarantee work, so not going with them

- 11) Paid for snow removal, plow damaged Post, have them on camera and they are paying for the repair
- 12) Replacing HVAC because failing, should be here any day, will get out of warehouse and install as soon as it gets here, also asked to look at heating and air on second floor. Should be damper over door in atlas room, should be able to use to regulate temp in that room

# b. General Manager Update

- 1) Ed and the committee have been busy at work, read communicator has all the information
- 2) Weekly Zoom meetings, January 25th &26th posted on 5 different venues, Post Commanders and Adjutants, direct email to the Springfield Chamber of Commerce, and will get on FB. Closing date February 25th. Working on scoring matrix. Once scored will identify those for interviews

#### 2. New Business:

- a. Dentz Fund Update
  - 1) Ed's motion passed at EXCOM
  - 2) Point of order, a motion was made that has not been discussed in the GM.
  - 3) Adjutant went back through meeting minutes, motion made to GM to use Dentz fund, tabled.
  - 4) Previous motions to pay off mortgage passed; however, funding was not identified.
  - 5) Nothing directly stating the funds would come from Eddy Dentz.
  - 6) Charlie first read bio on Eddy Dentz. Standing rule explicitly says all distributions from the Dentz fund are intended for American Legion chartable programs

**MOTION** – Motion to establish a new Post 176 Standing Committee entitled "Eddie Dentz Capital Asset Standing Committee" with Legionnaire John Sawyer, Esq., as the Chair, "To safeguard the bequeathed funds while establishing adequate controls to manage this asset, as well as managing the approval of all transactions."

- 1. Per Trust 20 % to American Legion Post 176 to be used for charitable purposes as its governing body determines
- 2. During pandemic, income dropped significantly, Revisit what we can use it for due to pandemic caused different circumstances
- 3. Haven't heard any discussion on intent to replace the money. The committee may not be necessary if money is going to be replaced
- 4. Committee should be comprised of members from the floor, not from the EXCOM because the EXCOM changes and the committee will provide continuity
- 5. The committee will make a recommendation to EXCOM and EXCOM would bring to GM
- 6. Committee will include 3-5 members, odd number of members important
- 7. Commander asks if he appoints members of the standing committees.

- 8. Committee will put transparency to the Dentz Fund
