Executive Session – Elections

Rex

- a. Rex Cunningham provided a short description of proposed actions for Post 176 2023-2024 elections. As the majority of incumbents were unopposed, a motion would be made to have a mass vote to elect all unopposed candidates. If approved, this vote would be conducted. Votes for remaining (contested) offices would be conducted by secret ballot, as required by Post 176 By-Laws. Each contested candidate was allowed 2 minutes to introduce themselves and announce what they wanted to contribute to our Post. The membership would then vote, pass their ballots to collectors who would bring the ballots to the tellers for counting. The tellers would count the ballots and produce a report for the Commander to review and announce the results to the Post. Post 176 Adjutant oversaw all vote counting.
- b. Rex proposed the motion that all unchallenged incumbents and unchallenged candidates be voted in mass, 2nd Kay. During the discussion, it was noted that the vote would require 2/3 of the body to pass. All unchallenged incumbent officers and Royes Gernandt, unchallenged candidate for Sergeant-at-Arms, were identified for the body. The motion carried.

- e. Elections for remaining offices, Finance Officer, Historian and Member-at-Large (3 Year) were then conducted.
- f. Roy Burton and Tim Nank competed for Post 176 Finance Officer. Commander Gaddis announced that Roy was the victor.
- g. Incumbent Scott Logan and Bob Loach competed for Post 176 Historian. The Commander announced that Scott was the victor.
- h. Mike Farabaugh, Tim Nank and Angela Wilder ran for the Member-at-Large vacancy. In the first round of voting, Tim Nank was eliminated. In the second round of voting, Angela Wilder was announced the victor.
- i. In the course of the first Member-at-Large vote, a teller report was passed to the commander that failed to clearly convey that no candidate achieved a majority and a second vote must be taken after eliminating the candidate with the least votes in the first round. The commander retracted an incorrect announcement and the Post proceeded with the second round of voting for Member-at-Large.
