Finance Budget Update

- 1. Hall Rental Income down ~\$15,000;
- 2. Payroll Expenses up ~\$18,000 3 paydays vs 2 per month; and
- 3. Upgraded Security Camera System increased expenses by ~ \$11,500.
- 4. Last month's ~\$28,000 deficit is consistent with the \$23K deficit we had last August.
